Course Overview

Enrollment Criteria	Students who would benefit from the origin of Go - China, a collection of excellent sports and culture, the basics of Go and the method of playing chess, develop intelligence, and develop emotional intelligence for children.
Engage and Assess	In the first weeks of the course, students will be taught the basic knowledge on the origin of Go, the concept of Qi, eating, pulling, running, basic rules;
Explore and Develop	In the middle weeks of the course, students will follow the basic method of playing chess in Go: eating, eating, eating, eating, eating, receiving, and eating basic training.
Refine and Present	In the final weeks of the course, students will be able to strengthen their game: the eating strategies and expand the small board practice. The teaching methods will be interspersed with stories, fables, explanations, student interactions, etc.
