Course Overview	
Enrollment Criteria	Students should enjoy books and know how to handle them with care. They should be able to follow basic instructions in English and be starting to use different strategies to read.
Engage and Assess	In the first weeks of the Chatterbooks book club, students will be assessed on their ability to read fluently and contribute to a discussion based on a shared story. We will listen to a range of texts together and begin reviewing these as a group.
Explore and Develop	In the middle weeks of the course, students will begin to develop a deeper understanding of stories read by exploring themes through writing, art or drama activities
Refine and Present	In the final weeks of the course, students will showcase their learning by completing book reviews of their favourite stories and sharing their thoughts and opinions with both their peers and parents.
Parent Engagement Opportunity	Parents will be invited to the final session of the Book Club to read and reflect with their children.
